

# AGC Education Foundation 2010 Scholarship Program

## COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS POSTMARK DEADLINE: March 1, 2010

### A. Eligibility

- Applicant **MUST** be a full-time student.
- Applicant **MUST** be a U.S. citizen or documented permanent resident of the United States (i.e. must possess a "green card").
- High School seniors are encouraged to apply. Scholarships are available for the Seattle Central Community College Woods program and those intending to pursue construction as a career through a two or four year college program.

#### University Construction Management Program

- 1) Must be pursuing a B.S. degree in Construction Management from a Washington State four-year university. The Construction Management program must be accredited.
- 2) Must be entering junior or senior year of university study in 2010-2011.
- 3) Must have an intention to continue their career in the construction industry.
- 4) Must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

#### Two Year Construction-Related Program

- 2) Must be pursuing a vocational certificate or two-year A.A. degree in a construction-related program from an accredited school.
- 3) May apply for first or second year of study.
- 4) Must have an intention to continue their career in the construction industry.
- 5) Must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or demonstrate achievement of competency.

### B. Requirements

- 1) Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are submitted as one package and postmarked by March 1, 2010:
  - completed and signed application
  - one letter of reference (not to exceed one page) from faculty advisor
  - one letter of reference from faculty, current or past employer, or unrelated adult
  - **official** grade transcript from each college attended, or high school transcript for high school seniors.
- 2) Incomplete application packages will NOT be considered.

### C. Awards

- 1) Several scholarships will be awarded at \$500 - \$5,000 per student per year. Scholarship recipients may be designated to receive one of the following awards:

- 2) Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by the Scholarship Committee of the AGC Education Foundation, which will consider applicant's interest in the construction industry, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, references, and financial need.
- 3) All applicants selected as semi-finalists will be subject to a personal interview with representatives of the Education Foundation.
- 4) Scholarship recipients will be notified in June, 2010.
- 5) **Grade transcripts and upcoming class schedule must be forwarded at the conclusion of each academic period.** Recipient will not be reminded to provide this information; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the scholarship program.
- 6) Checks will be sent directly to designated colleges or universities on a quarterly or semester basis after recipients have returned their transcripts and upcoming class schedules.
- 7) Recipient is encouraged to seek summer employment in construction at some time during undergraduate enrollment.
- 8) Recipient is responsible for keeping the AGC Education Foundation up-to-date on address, phone number and e-mail changes.
